

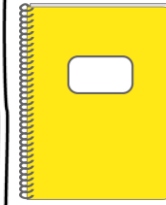
The FFA portion of the grade is evaluated by participation in 3 FFA leadership development events per semester. Students are required to take part in a Supervised Agricultural Experience project and complete the FFA Record Book.

Students will participate in an income and expense simulation over the course of the year while keeping checkbook registers.

As an Ag Academy course there will be 2 field trips, a mock congress simulation, and a constitutional speech assignment.
