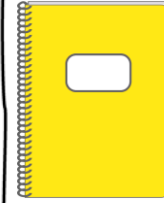

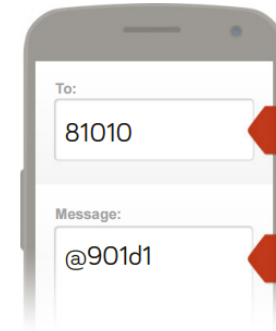


For class you will need a spiral notebook and a writing utensil.
